Clean or Replace Range Hood Filters

Maintenance Steps

- 1 ■ Remove and inspect your range hood filter monthly.
- 2 ■ Soak metal filters in hot, soapy water to break down grease.
- 3 ■ Use baking soda for tough buildup.
- 4 ■ Replace charcoal filters if your hood is ductless.
- 5 ■ Let filters fully dry before reinstalling.
